Society members receive our Journal called "The Sound Box". The Sound Box is published four times a year and is 36 pages packed with in-depth research articles by outstanding authors such as Julien Anton (The Earliest Toy Phonographs in Europe), Bob Baumbach (The Voice of Victor), Allen Koenigsberg (The Origins of Zonophone), George Paul (The "Ideal" Self-Supporting Aluminum Horn), and René Rondeau (The Palmodian - The Violin That Sings).
